Muhammadu Marwa (Alias Maitatsine) Movement (Declaration as Unlawful Society) Order 1982

Commencement: 18th November 1982

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 62 (2) (ii) of the Criminal Code, and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I, Shehu Usman Aliyu Shagari, President of the Federal Republic of Nigeria and Commander-in-Chief of the Armed Forces of the Federation, hereby make the following order:—

1. Pursuant to section 62 (2) (ii) of the Criminal Code, the Muhammadu Marwa (Alias Maitatsine) Movement, commonly known and referred to as the Maitatsine Movement, is hereby declared to be an unlawful society.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note does not form part of the above Order but is intended to explain its purport)

The Order declares the Muhammadu Marwa (Alias Maitatsine) Movement (commonly known and referred to as the Maitatsine Movement) as an unlawful society. Consequently, the movement is liable to dissolution while any property belonging thereto is liable to forfeiture to the State.
