THE ARCHITECTS (REGISTRATION, ETC.) ACT 1969 (1969 No. 10)

The Architects (Constitution of Registration Council)
(Amendment) Regulations 1984

Commencement: 11th July 1984

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 2 (4) of the Architects (Registration, etc.) Act 1969 and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf I, the Minister of Works and Housing, hereby make the following regulations:—

1. For subsection (2) of section 2 of the Architects (Registration, etc.) Act 1969 there shall be substituted the following new subsection, that is—

Amendment of 1969 No. 10.

- "(2) Subject to the provisions of this Act, the council shall consist of a total of fifteen members and shall be comprised by—
 - (a) one person who shall be the President of the Council;
 - (b) four persons to be appointed by the Minister charged with responsibility for the architectural profession of whom one shall be employed by the Ministry under his control to represent the various interests in architecture;
 - (c) four persons to represent the States of the Federation on a rotational basis; each such representative to be nominated by the Military Governor of his State and appointed by the Minister;
 - (d) three persons to represent the universities in Nigeria, having faculties of architecture; each university having not more than one representative at a time; and
 - (e) three persons elected by the Nigerian Institute of Architects.
- 2. These regulations may be cited as the Architects (Constitution of Citation. Registration Council) (Amendment) Regulations 1984.
