PUBLIC HOLIDAYS (AMENDMENT) DECREE 1984



Decree No. 26

[28th August 1984]

Commence-

THE FEDERAL MILITARY GOVERNMENT hereby decrees as follows:—

1. The Schedule to the Public Holidays Act 1979 is hereby amended as follows, that is—

Amendment of 1979 No. 3.

- (a) by inserting immediately after paragraph 3 thereof the following new paragraph:—
 - "4. Workers' day (1st May)"; and
- (b) by re-numbering paragraphs 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8 as 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9 respectively.
- This Decree may be cited as the Public Holidays (Amendment) Citation. Decree 1984.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The Decree amends the Public Holidays Act 1979 to appoint the first day of May as a public holiday throughout the Federation.
