NIGERIAN STANDARDS ORGANISATION (AMENDMENT) DECREE 1984



Decree No. 32

[27th November 1984]

Commencement.

THE FEDERAL MILITARY GOVERNMENT hereby decrees as follows:—

1. The Nigerian Standards Organisation Act 1971 is hereby amended by deleting the words "Nigerian Standards Organisation" wherever it appears in the Act and substituting therewith the words "the Standards Organisation of Nigeria".

2. This Decree may be cited as the Nigerian Standards Organisation Cite (Amendment) Decree 1984.

The above Decree changes the name of the Nigerian Standards Organisation to Standards Organisation of Nigeria to avoid any possible conflict with the Nigerian Security Organisation.
