## ROBBERY AND FIREARMS (SPECIAL PROVISIONS) (AMENDMENT) (No. 2) DECREE 1984



## Decree No. 33

[31st December 1983]

Commencement,

THE FEDERAL MILITARY GOVERNMENT hereby decrees as follows:—

1. For paragraph (9) of subsection (2) of section 6 of the Robbery and Firearms (Special Provisions) Decree 1984, as amended by the Robbery and Firearms (Special Provisions) (Amendment) Decree 1984, there shall be substituted the following new paragraph:—

Amendment of 1984 No. 5. 1984 No. 21.

- "(a) a serving or retired Judge of a High Court or any court of like jurisdiction, whether or not of the State concerned, who shall be Chairman:"
- 2. This Decree may be cited as the Robbery and Firearms (Special Provisions) (Amendment) (No. 2) Decree 1984 and shall be deemed to have come into force on 31st December 1983.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note does not form part of the above Decree but is intended to explain its purpose)

The Decree further amends the Robbery and Firearms (Special Provisions) Decree 1984 to authorise the appointment of a serving or retired Judge of any High Court or other court of equivalent jurisdiction (whether or not of the State concerned) as Chairman of a Robbery and Firearms Tribunal set up for that State.
