PORTS ACT (CAP. 155)

Nigerian Ports Authority (Dues and Rates) (Amendment) Regulations 1989

Commencement: 7th June 1989

In exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 82 of the Ports Act and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, the Nigerian Ports Authority hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. The Nigerian Ports Authority (Dues and Rates) Regulations 1987 are hereby amended in regulation 1 by inserting immediately after paragraph (2) thereof, the following new paragraphs, that is—

Amendment of S.I. 11 of 1987.

- "(3) Notwithstanding any other provisions to the contrary in these Regulations, the rates quoted in respect of all ship dues and charges, harbour dues, stevedoring charges, cranage rates, container facility charges and wharfages, in circumstances where stevedoring is not applicable, shall be deemed to have been quoted in US dollars.
- (4) For the avoidance of doubt, nothing in paragraph (3) of this regulation shall be construed as compelling national carriers (as defined under the National Shipping Policy Decree 1987) to pay the rates quoted in these Regulations in US dollars or any other foreign exchange for services rendered to national carrier vessels by the Authority.".
- 2. These Regulations may be cited as the Nigerian Ports Authority (Dues Citation. and Rates) (Amendment) Regulations 1989.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The Regulations amend the Nigerian Ports Authority (Dues and Rates) Regulations 1987 to make the rates specified for certain facilities provided by the Authority to be paid in US dollars.
