Commencement.

THE FEDERAL MILITARY GOVERNMENT hereby decrees as follows :--

1. Subsection (4) of section 31 of the Supreme Court Act 1960 is hereby amended by deleting the words "except in the case of a conviction involving sentence of death" as it appears therein and substituting therefor the words, "of this section."

2. This Decree may be cited as the Supreme Court of Nigeria Cited (Amendment) Decree 1989.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note does not form part of the above Decree but is intended to explain its purport)

The Decree amends the Supreme Court of Nigeria Act 1960 to empower the Supreme Court to extend the period to appeal to the Court to include the cases of conviction involving sentence of death.
