GUIDELINES FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF THE NATIONAL
ANTI-CORRUPTION STRATEGY (NACS) 2017-2021

[24th Day of October, 2019]

Commence-
ment.

WHEREAS the Attorney-General of the Federation and Minister of Justice is empowered under Paragraph 5.0 of the National Anti-corruption Strategy 2017-2021 to co-ordinate and issue policy directives from time to time ; and

WHEREAS in July 2017, the Federal Executive Council has directed the Attorney-General of the Federation and Minister of Justice to robustly implement the National Anti-Corruption Strategy ;

NOW THEREFORE in exercise of the powers conferred on me by Paragraph 5.0 of the National Anti-corruption Strategy 2017-2021 and all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I, Abubakar Malami, SAN, the Attorney-General of the Federation and Minister of Justice issue the following guidelines—

1. In order to ensure an effective co-ordination in the implementation of the National Anti-corruption Strategy—

General
provisions.

(a) the Secretariat for the Implementation of the National Anti-Corruption Strategy shall be in the Office of the Attorney-General of the Federation and Minister of Justice ;

(b) the Technical Committee of the National Anti-Corruption Strategy is dissolved and all activities of the Technical Committee shall be conducted by the Secretariat on the Implementation of the National Anti-Corruption Strategy ;

(c) the Attorney-General of the Federation and Minister of Justice shall be the Central Authority in matters related to the fight against corruption ;

(d) the Attorney-General of the Federation and Minister of Justice shall be the Focal Person on all local and International interactions on Anti-Corruption matters ;

(e) all Ministries, Departments or Agencies and Committees seeking to conduct, organize or host programs on the fight against corruption shall seek and obtain clearance of the Attorney-General of the Federation and Minister of Justice ;

Application.

(f) all Ministries, Departments and Agencies and Committees shall seek and obtain clearance of the Attorney-General of the Federation and Minister of Justice on donor assisted project ;

(g) the Technical Unit on Governance and Anti-Corruption Reforms shall remain the Secretariat for the Inter-Agency Task Force and shall report its activities monthly to the Office of the Attorney-General of the Federation and Minister of Justice ; and

(h) all Heads of Law Enforcement Agencies and Anti-Corruption Agencies shall report to the Office of the Attorney-General of the Federation and Minister of Justice quarterly on all Anti-Corruption activities.

Non-
compliance.

2. Failure to comply with the provisions of this guideline shall be deemed to be insubordination as defined under the Public Service Rules. '
