Note—The balance with Treasury of £6,886,190-14s-0d at 31st March, 1956 was transferred to the newly constituted Development Fund on 1st April, 1956, in accordance with a Resolution passed in House of Representatives on 15th March, 1956.

TERMS OF LOANS

The capital structure of the Electricity Corporation is at present under review with the object of consolidating all loans made to the Corporation prior to the 1st April, 1955, for which the Corporation will then issue debenture stock, and of providing for the interest and repayment terms of the loans made after that date. Most of the loans are interest free until assets become revenue earning: *vide* paragraph 22 of the White Paper on the Capital Requirements of the Electricity Corporation of Nigeria (tabled March 1954).

2. The position with regard to the two Loans to the Cameroons Development Corporation still outstanding, is as follows:—

(a) Loan of £500,000 carries interest at 4½ per cent per annum and is repayable in 15 equated annual instalments, the first instalment having been paid on 21st July, 1955.

(b) Loan of £550,000 carries interest at 3½ per cent per annum only during the five years 1955-60 and is thereafter repayable in 15 equated annual instalments without interest, the first instalment being due on 2nd July, 1961.

TERMS OF LOANS—*continued*

3. The loans of £100,000 and £500,000 to the Lagos Executive Development Board are interest free for two years; interest is payable at $4\frac{1}{2}$ per cent per annum for the next eight years, and thereafter the loans are repayable in 30 equated annual instalments with interest at $4\frac{1}{2}$ per cent per annum.

4. The loan to the Nigeria Ports Authority is for working capital. The terms have not yet been decided.

5. The expenditure on the Apapa Wharf Extension was authorised by Special Warrant No. "D" 2/1954-55 and Loan Development Fund Warrant 1955-56 dated 1st April, 1955.
