DEPARTMENT OF MARKETING AND EXPORTS VACANCY FOR MARKETING OFFICER

Applications are invited from suitably qualified candidates for appointment to the post of Marketing Officer in the Department of Marketing and Exports.

Scale of salary.—C (E) 2, 3, 4, 5—6564-24-612; 684-30-864; 6900-36-972; 61,014-42-1,140.

Qualifications.—Candidates, preferably under 35 years of age, should possess a degree in Ronomics or Commerce or either have a diploma from or be members of a recognized Institute of Commerce. Applications will also be considered from candidates who have had several years good commercial experience in a responsible capacity but who do not

possess the above noted qualifications. Tact, initiative and administrative ability are essential. They will normally be stationed in Lagos, Kano, Ibadan or Port Harcourt, but may have to tour in other districts of Nigeria. Preference will be given to candidates with practical experience of the duties outlined below.

Duties .- The Department of Marketing and Exports acts as the executive of the Nigeria Produce Marketing Boards which are responsible for handling the country's exportable surplus of the main crops, cocos, groundnuts, palm kernels, palm oil and cotton. The Marketing Division of the Department is mainly concerned with these functions and the officers selected will be required to deal with matters connected with the controlled marketing, evacuation and shipment of Marketing Boards produce from Nigeria. The duties involve correspondence and direct negotiations with buying agents in regard to matters affecting marketing, from buying stations up-country to the time of delivery on board ocean vessel. The subjects dealt with by the Department include the prescription of buying prices and transport differentials, inspection, grading, storage, handling, containers, means of conveyance to port, lighterage, check weighing, the transmission of shipping documents and the maintenance of statistics. Marketing Officers are required to advise on matters of policy in regard to produce marketing and to advise Nigerian shippers in matters regarding the export trade in general.

Other conditions of service.—(i) The post is pensionable and appointment will be on probation for three years.

- (ii) An outfit allowance of £60 is payable on first appointment.
- (iii) Rent is payable at the rate of 81 per cent of salary when an officer is occupying Government Quarters.
