Nigeria (Constitution) Orders in Council, 1954 to-1958

NOTIFICATION OF RESIGNATION OF TWO MINISTERS AND TWO PARLIAMENTARY SECRETARIES

It is notified that the following two Ministers and two Parliamentary Secretaries have availed themselves of sections 91 and 99 of the Nigeria (Constitution) Order in Council, 1954, and have resigned their seats and offices by notice in writing under their respective hands addressed to the Governor-General. The resignations are effective from the 26th July, 1958:—

Dr. the Honourable K. O. Mbadiwe, M.H.R., Minister of Commerce and Industry.

The Honourable Chief Kolawole Balogun, M.H.R., Minister of Research and Information.

U. O. Ndem, Esq., M.H.R., Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister of Commerce and Industry.

O. Bademosi, Esq., M.H.R., Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister of Research and Information.

With effect from the 26th of July, 1958, the assignment of responsibilities to the two Ministers specified, and the temporary limited re-assignment to the Honourable Chief Kolawole Balogun, M.H.R. of responsibility in respect of the Ministry of Education, cease to have effect, and a further assignment of all such responsibilities will be made.
