### BRITISH COUNCIL COURSE ON CENTRAL GOVERNMENT ADMINISTRATION IN THE UNITED KINGDOM

It is notified for the information of members of the Federal Public Service that the British Council is offering a two-month course on the principles and methods of Central Government Administration in Britain. The course, which will be based on London, will be held from the 7th of June to the 25th of July, 1959, and will be directed by Mr S. A. (iv) the relationship between Central and Local Government ;

(v) the role of the Civil Service, its recruitment, establishment work and training ;

(vi) the explanation to the public of measures taken, relations with the Press, the home information services of the Government.

3. A list of suggested reading material will be issued to each accepted member of the course.

4. In the second part of the course these sepects will be illustrated by particular enquiry into the work of certain Departments of State, and it is hoped to arrange practical attachments for members. As far as possible the Departments selected for attachments will be those whose work relates to members' experience in their own countries.

5. The third part of the course will provide for a general evaluation. Group discussions will be organised so that members may compare their attachments and consider any points arising either from these or from the first part of the course, Certain issues may be selected beforehand for special consideration.

6. Applications by Federal Government officers who will be eligible for overseas leave at the time of the course are invited, and should be sent to the Federal Establishment Secretary through Heads of Departments, who are asked to give their recommendations and the details required under Chapter 18 of General Orders. Officers who are nominated will be eligible for the usual allowances and refund of expenses in accordance with General Order 18205. Preference in selection will be given to Administrative and Executive Officers, and others whose dutics are closely related to the subject of the course.
