It is announced that the Governor-General's Deputy, on the recommendation of the Prime Minister, and in accordance with the provisions of section 94 of the Nigeria (Constitution) Order in Council, 1954, has with effect from the 5th day of July, 1959, temporarily assigned to him the Honourable MUHAMMADU RIBADU, M.B.E., M.H.R., with responsibility, so far as that the Hon. Member has to be discharged within the Federation, for the matters or groups of matters and for the Departments of Government for which the Honourable Chief Festus Okotie-Eboh, M.H.R., was immediately before such date charged with responsibility.

The Honourable Chief Festus Okotie-Eboh, M.H.R., will continue to be charged with responsibility for such matters or groups of matters and for such Departments of Government except so far as that responsibility falls to be discharged within the Federation, and will re-assume full responsibility from the date of his return to Nigeria as imposed in the Gazette.
