Post-registration candidates must be fully registered medical practitioners and should be prepared to serve in any of the following departments: Medicine, Surgery, Obstetrics, Paediatrics, Anaesthetics and General Out-Patients.

The appointments will be for one tour of twelve months, six months to be spent in each of two Departments, as far as possible, in accordance with the candidates' preference.

The salaries offered for the posts are :—

AUDIT DEPARTMENT, NORTHERN REGION VACANCIES FOR ASSISTANT AUDITORS, EXAMINERS OF ACCOUNTS AND PROVINCIAL SUPERVISORS OF ACCOUNTS

Applications are invited from suitably qualified candidates of Northern Origin for appointment to the following posts in the Audit Department of the Northern Region:

I. ASSISTANT AUDITOR

A. *Qualifications* : Candidates should either—

(i) hold a Degree, preferably with Honours, from a recognised University, or its equivalent, or

(ii) be Associate Members of one of the following : Institute of Chartered Accountants (England, Scotland and Ireland); Society of Incorporated Accountants and Auditors; Association of Certified and Corporate Accountants; Institute of Cost and Works Accountants; Institute of Municipal Treasurers and Accountants; or

(iii) have had a good Secondary or Middle School education and considerable and varied experience of either Government, Local Government or Commercial accounting, and must be able to show proof, in their employment since leaving school, of ability, energy, responsibility and adaptability. Candidates with these qualifications may be required to undertake a further course as Assistant Auditors-in-Training before appointment as Assistant Auditors.

Candidates must be physically fit and under 35 years of age on 31st July, 1959.

B. *Scale of salary*.—The salary scale offered will be related to the qualifications referred to above, as follows :—

(i) £624-1,140 in Scale A1 Lower Segment (Honours Degrees) £600-1,140 in Scale B 1. 2. 3 (Other Degrees).

(ii) Scale A 1 Lower Segment (Advanced entry point) : £845-42-1,140;

(iii) £600-1,140 in Scale B 1, 2, 3 (as at (1)) or £540-714 in Scale C(E) 2, if appointed as Assistant Auditors-in-Training.

C. Duties.—The persons appointed will be required to assist in auditing Regional Government and Local Government Accounts and such other public accounts as are subject to audit by the Director of Audit, Northern Region. The performance of these duties will involve a considerable amount of touring, and officers appointed must be prepared to live in bush rest-houses or similar accommodation for extensive periods.

D. Other conditions of service.—(i) The appointments will be on probation for three years on pensionable terms.

(ii) Rent is payable at the rate of 8½ per cent of basic salary, subject to a maximum of £150 per annum when an officer is occupying Government quarters.

(iii) An Outfit Allowance of £45 and a Touring Equipment Allowance of £40 are, under certain conditions, payable on first appointment.

(iv) In certain circumstances, other allowances in respect of children, transport, travelling, disturbance, etc., are payable.

2. EXAMINERS OF ACCOUNTS

A. Qualifications:

(i) Direct Entry:

(a) A pass in two subjects (including book-keeping) in the Intermediate examinations of those professional bodies referred to in paragraph 1A (ii) above, or,

(b) A University Intermediate degree; a Higher School Certificate with three principal passes on one occasion or four principal passes on two occasions; G.C.E. with three passes at advanced level on one occasion or four passes at advanced level on two occasions; or,

(c) A Diploma in N.T. Accounting from the Institute of Administration, Zaria, or,

(d) A pass in the Executive Officer-in-Training Course.

(ii) In-Service:

(a) A group Certificate for Commercial Subjects Stage I, R.S.A., or, a pass in Book-keeping R.S.A. Stage II, or,

(b) A Diploma in N.T. Accounting from the Institute of Administration, Zaria, or,

(c) A pass in the Executive Officer-in-Training Course, or

(d) Successful completion of the In-Service Accountancy Course of the Nigerian College of Arts, Science and Technology.

In addition a candidate must satisfy the Director of Audit as to his aptitude for Audit Duties and his ability to work without close supervision.

B. Salary scale.—C(E) Training 1, 2.

C. Duties.—Examiners of accounts are of Assistant Executive Officer grade and are expected to be capable of relieving senior officers of a considerable proportion of routine supervision. They are also required to work on their own, conducting particular sections of audit work and supervising subordinate clerical staff.

D. Training and Advancement.—After experience has been gained and suitable diligence and ability indicated, officers are considered for promotion to the Senior Examiner (Scale C(E) 2, 3, 4) or higher grades.

3. PROVINCIAL SUPERVISORS OF ACCOUNTS

A. Qualifications.—Considerable experience of Local Government Accounting together with a Diploma in Native Treasury Accounting from the Institute of Administration, Zaria. Exceptionally an Intermediate Certificate is accepted if the candidate is otherwise well qualified.

B. Salary scale.—C(E) Training 1, 2.

C. Duties.—Visiting the various Native Treasuries in the Province to which they are posted and undertaking specified checks of the accounts and records maintained by the Native Authorities. Provincial Supervisors of Accounts also give advice and guidance to accounting officers employed by the Native Authorities wherever it is required.

D. Training and Advancement.—After experience has been gained and suitable diligence and ability indicated, officers are considered for promotion to the Assistant Auditor grade.

Method of application.—Applications for any of the above appointments giving full details of qualifications and experience should be addressed to the Secretary, Public Service Commission, Northern Region, so as to reach him not later than 31st July, 1959.
