(a) *Insert paragraph 2B.*—"Auto Gas Oil—Under the provisions of the Revenue Allocation (Motor Spirit and Diesel Oil Returns) Regulations, 1959 (Legal Notice No. 116 of 1959), registered importers are required to render returns in accordance with Government Notice No. 1281 (Customs and Excise Notice No. 19) of 1959. Bills of entry for this commodity may not contain particulars of goods of any other description".

(b) *Insert paragraph 3A.*—"Diesel Oil—Under the provisions of the Revenue Allocation (Motor Spirit and Diesel Oil Returns) Regulations, 1959 (Legal Notice No. 116 of 1959), registered importers are required to render returns in accordance with Government Notice No. 1281 (Customs and Excise Notice No. 19) of 1959. Bills of entry for this commodity may not contain particulars of goods of any other description".

(c) *Insert paragraph 7A.*—"Medicinal Preparations, Anaesthetics, Dressings and Drugs—Importers who claim exemption from duty under item 38 of the Second Schedule to the Customs Tariff Ordinance (No. 60) 1958 are required to make a declaration on the relevant bill of entry that the goods are imported solely for use as (or in compounding) medicinal preparations, anaesthetics, dressings or drugs".

(d) *Delete paragraph 8 and substitute.*—"8. Motor Spirit—Importers are required to be registered under the provisions of the Motor Spirit (Returns) Ordinance (No. 5) 1952 and, under the provisions of the Revenue Allocation (Motor Spirit and Diesel Oil Returns) Regulations, 1959 (Legal Notice No. 116 of 1959), registered importers are required to render returns in accordance with Government Notice No. 1281 (Customs and Excise Notice No. 19) of 1959. Bills of entry for this commodity may not contain particulars of goods of any other description".

(e) *Insert paragraph 11A.*—"Stationery, Duplicators, Models, etc.—

(i) Any educational establishment which desires to claim exemption from duty under item 65 of the Second Schedule to the Customs Tariff Ordinance (No. 60) 1958 is required to submit with the relevant bill of entry a certificate indicating that the signatory is satisfied that the goods in that particular consignment are for use only in educational establishments.

(ii) The signatories approved for the certificate are:

(The procedure for such stationery, duplicators, models, etc., imported by parcels post, is laid down in Government Notice No. 2118 (Customs and Excise Notice, No. 20) 1959).

(f) *Delete paragraph 12 and substitute.*—"12. Tobacco—This includes unmanufactured tobacco, manufactured tobacco, cigarettes, cigars and snuff, and may be imported only by holders of a licence issued under the Tobacco (Licences and Returns) Ordinance (No. 1) 1952, except where otherwise allowed under that Ordinance. Bills of entry for this commodity may not contain particulars of goods of any other description".
