WHEREAS by section 138 of the Nigeria (Constitution) Order in Council, 1954 (as the same has been amended from time to time) it is provided that the Judges of the Federal Supreme Court shall be a Chief Justice of the Federation, and two Federal Justices, or such greater number as may be prescribed by or under any law enacted by the Federal Legislature:

AND WHEREAS it is provided by the Federal Supreme Court (General Provisions) Ordinance, 1955, that such court shall consist of such number of Federal Justices, in addition to the Chief Justice of the Federation, as I may direct, in pursuance of which authority I have directed that such court shall consist in addition to the Chief Justice, of five Federal Justices:

AND WHEREAS by section 139 of the said Order in Council it is further provided that the Federal Justices shall be appointed by the Governor-General by Instrument under the Public Seal in pursuance of instructions given by Her Majesty through the Secretary of State :

REPORT OF THE DIRECTOR OF FEDERAL AUDIT ON THE BALANCE SHEET AS AT 31ST MARCH, 1959, AND THE STATEMENT OF RECEIPTS AND PAYMENTS ON RECURRENT ACCOUNT FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31ST MARCH, 1959, OF THE NIGERIAN COLLEGE

OF ARTS. SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY

COLLEGE RECURRENT RESERVE : £100,176.

This amount represents 15 per cent of the net estimated expenditure for 1959-60 as approved by the Council of the College. It was observed however, that the estimated expenditure for 1959-60 was reduced following correspondence with the Federal Government by £19,500, but no corresponding reduction has been made in the amount of the Recurrent Reserve retained by the College.

2. STUDENTS' RECEIPTS AND PAYMENTS : £1,244-17s-9d

This sum represents amounts held on deposit in respect of Laboratory Deposits and Caution Money, but no reconciliation of this figure with the balances due to individual students has been seen.

3. SUNDRY CREDITORS (STORES): £210

DIFFERENCE IN GENERAL STORES : £213-7s-3d

Satisfactory explanations of the discrepancies found between the stores on hand and the Stores Ledger balances of the three branches have not been seen, nor has the item of £210 due on the Stores Account yet been finally verified. This matter is under correspondence.

4. ADVANCES TO COLLEGE STAFF : £41,410-11s-0d

Reconciliation of this balance with the total of the balances of the individual advances which was referred to in paragraph 4 of the Audit Report for 1957-58, has still not been seen.

5. STUDENTS' RECEIPTS AND PAYMENTS : £4,037-3s-1d

This sum represents advances made to students in respect of pocket money and book money, but no reconciliation has been seen of this figure with the balances due from individual students.

6. The Statement and Valuation of assets required by section 23 (1) of the Nigerian College of Arts, Science and Technology Ordinance, 1952, has not vet been rendered.

7. EXCESS EXPENDITURE

TRAINING OF NIGERIANS AS COMMERCIAL PILOTS

The Federal Government has introduced a training scheme for suitably qualified young men to train as commercial pilots and to take their places in Nigeria's developing civil aviation. To be eligible for training under this scheme candidates must be aged between 17 and 25 years and hold the West African School Certificate (or equivalent), with credits in English Language and Mathematics : candidates with higher educational qualifications will receive preference. A high standard of physical fitness is essential.

2. An initial training course of about three months duration will be held at the flying school near Lagos, during which successful candidates will be paid a salary or allowances of \pounds 12-10s per month and provided with uniform and flying clothing. They will, however, have to make their own arrangements for board and lodging.

3. On completion of the initial training course successful candidates will qualify for the private pilot's licence and the more outstanding pupils will be eligible for selection for further training in the United Kingdom, the successful completion of which would make them eligible for the commercial pilot's licence. During this advanced training the Federal Government's scholarship rates will be paid, together with all the usual allowances.

4. Successful candidates returning to Nigeria with commercial licences will be offered appointment with Nigeria Airways, but there may also be opportunities for employment in the Northern Region communications flight and with Nigerian non-scheduled operators. Holders of commercial licences appointed to Nigeria Airways would begin their careers as second officers and with experience would be required to gain higher qualifications, making them eligible for promotion, ultimately to the responsibility of having their own command. Somewhat similar arrangements would apply to those taking up other air crew appointments.

5. The Federal Government also requires a large number of air traffic control officers and it may be possible to offer candidates who satisfactorily complete the initial flying training course, but who are not selected for advanced training in the United Kingdom, an opportunity to train for these posts. Candidates selected for training as air traffic control officers would be required to undergo extensive instruction in Nigeria and probably overseas. The present scale for air traffic control officers in the Ministry of Transport and Aviation is Scale B1-B4 (\pounds 690- \pounds 1,584) with a few higher posts graded in Group 9 (\pounds 1,728).
