Industrial Development (Import Duties Relief) Ordinance 1957

> Application for Repayment of Import Duty

The following particulars of an application for repayment of import duty are notified in accordance with Regulation 5 (3) (b) of the Industrial Development (Import Duties Relief) Regulations, 1957:

Industry.—The manufacture/packaging of chemical materials and products such as insecticides, fungicides and disinfectants, including weed killing preparations, and similar health and agricultural preparations.

Materials in respect of which relief is sought— Kerosene, Gas oil, Petroleum, Naphtha and other chemicals.

Section of the Ordinance under which relief is sought-Section 5

2. As provided in Regulation 5 (3) (b) any person who objects to the granting of this relief should notify his objection and the reasons for it in writing to the Permanent Secretary, Federal Ministry of Commerce and Industry, within 30 days of the date of publication of this notice.
