The London Agents of the Elder Dempster Agencies Limited have issued the under-noted circular regarding the cost of clearing and forwarding of unaccompanied personal effects from the London Docks to the final home address of the owners:—

"On several occasions recently individuals shipping personal effects and sundry items from Lagos by the *Winneba* and *Calabar* have been disconcerted to find that further charges were payable in London before they could obtain delivery. From what we have been told, it appears that the Forwarding Agents in Lagos normally collect a deposit which covers the ocean freight and your local charges and the individual assumes that the personal effects will then be discharged and delivered to his home address without further payment. This is not, of course, correct, and you may like to have a note of the following charges which are incurred in London:—

Port Rates at 9s per ton wt.

Port of London Authority landing and delivery at 160s per ton wt. + 62 per cent.

After three free days, P.L.A. rent is then due at 4s per ton wt. + 25 per cent.

In addition, we or the Forwarding Agents appointed would require a deposit to cover carriage charges, Customs clearance, and Agency fee. Altogether, it is probable that for each case of personal effects which is required to be cleared through Customs and delivered, a deposit of about £5 will be required, assuming that ocean freight has been prepaid and that there is not duty or Purchase Tax due."
