UNESCO is offering the following awards:

A. Fellowships and Scholarships to train Nigerians for staffing Nigerian Universities and Advanced Teacher Training Colleges, in the following fields:—

- (i) *Basic Sciences*.—Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Geology.
- (ii) *Social Sciences*.—Sociology, Statistics, Economics, Political Science, Public Administration.
- (iii) *Humanities*.—Philosophy, History, African Culture.
- (iv) *Mass Communication*.—Teaching of Journalism, use of Audiovisual Methods.

These awards will be for ONE to FOUR years as necessary in any of the following countries: Argentina, China, France, Malagasy, Morocco, New Zealand, Sudan, Switzerland, U.S.S.R.

2. They will be awarded only to:—

- (i) promising university under-graduates,
- (ii) those who already have a bachelor's degree and wish to proceed to a master's degree,
- (iii) those who have a master's degree and wish to proceed to a doctorate.

3. Candidates must have a knowledge of the official language of the country of study to have preference.

B. Fellowships to Four graduates to be employed ultimately in the Institute of Educational Research on successful completion of 9 months' course in Nigeria (one month) and the U.S.A. (eight months).

C. One Fellowship for a six month course for Writers, Composers and Artists, tenable in any country.

D. Six Fellowships in the field of Adult Education for a duration of six months tenable in the United Kingdom, Denmark, Yugoslavia and Turkey.

Candidates applying for these Fellowships should have several years of experience in Adult Education or Rural Education.

E. Five Participants to undertake a course in Production of Reading Materials for new literates at Nairobi, Kenya, from 16-7-62 to 3-8-62.
