FEDERAL GOVERNMENT SCHOLARSHIPS, 1962

Object.—In order to meet Nigeria's growing needs in high-level manpower the Federal Government proposes to continue its present policy of offering scholarships for under-graduate study in local institutions of higher learning as well as in institutions abroad. In 1959 the number of Federal Government Scholarship Awards was increased from 180 to 540 for each of the two years 1959/1960 and 1960/1961. For each of the next two years 1962/1963 and 1963/1964 the Government proposes to award a total of 1,050 scholarships under four categories as follows:—

(1) Post-graduate studies—120

(ii) First degree courses and other under-graduate and professional studies—600 (200 reserved for the Northern Region)

(iii) Special university and other post-secondary scholarships for candidates of Northern Region, Niger Delta special area and Federal Territory of Lagos.—120

(iv) Special Secondary School scholarships for candidates of Northern Region, Niger Delta special area and Federal Territory of Lagos.—210.

These scholarships are designed for the training of Nigerians not only for services of professional, technical and administrative nature in the Federal Public Service but also for teaching in Voluntary Agency Institutions of learning and for services in the Statutory Corporations. Selected candidates will be

required to enter into bonds to serve as directed by the Federal Government on the completion of their training. Administration of the scholarships under categories (iii) and (iv) will be carried out by special arrangements.

This notice is concerned with scholarships for first degree courses and other under-graduate and professional studies.

2. *Courses.*—Training under this scholarship scheme will be for the Federal Public Service and for service with the Statutory Corporations. Awards will be given in accordance with the anticipated needs of these services as indicated by the Nigerianisation Officer. Awards will be made in particular in the following fields of study for a first degree or professional courses:—

Accountancy, Administration, Agriculture, Anthropology, Archaeology, Architecture, Aviation, Banking, Building Technology, Commercial Arts, Company Secretaryship, Dentistry, Drama and Music, Engineering (various), Estate Management, Journalism, Librarianship, Medicine, Modern Languages, Printing, Radio and Television, Radar Technology, Telecommunications, Social and Home Sciences, Sociology, Statistics and Surveying.

Awards will also be made for first degree courses in the usual Arts subjects and in Natural Sciences, including Mathematics (Pure and Applied), Biology, Botany, Zoology, Chemistry, Biochemistry and Physics, and Geology. (In the case of Engineering consideration will be given to any branch of Engineering studied at the first degree or professional level).

3. *Training for Teaching.*—Candidates wishing to teach in secondary schools, technical institutes and trade centres will be given especially favourable consideration. Awards will be given:—

(a) for courses leading to a general or honours degree in any subject taught in the post-primary curriculum of Nigerian educational institutions;

(b) for professional training of teachers at various levels;

(c) for courses leading to graduate qualifications in Engineering or leading to the professional qualifications of the Engineering Institutions including courses leading to Higher National Certificates.

4. *Awards for Lagos.*—There will be special awards for students born or permanently domiciled in Lagos. Awards in this category, which will not involve bonding to serve as directed by the Federal Government, will be made for:—

(a) general or honours degree courses in Mathematics and Science;

(b) a first degree or professional course in Dentistry or Medicine;

(c) higher professional courses in Accountancy, Librarianship, Pharmacy, Secretaryship, Teaching and the Fine Arts.

5. *Training awards.*—Persons in the Federal Public Service and Statutory Corporations holding permanent and pensionable posts or equivalent positions who wish to pursue courses of study

related to work of their departments or corporations may not apply for scholarships under this Notice, but should apply for training awards, through their Heads of Department or Corporation, to the Nigerianisation Officer.

6. *Qualifications.*—Candidates should ensure that they hold the necessary academic qualifications before applying. The following points should be noted:—

(a) *for degree courses.*—no candidate will be considered for an award who does not have the necessary academic qualifications for *direct* entry to a university, i.e. usual passes in appropriate subjects at G.C.E. 'A' Level or its equivalent or H.S.C. at "Principal" Level;

(b) *for other courses.*—no candidate will be considered for an award who does not hold at least Grade II School Certificate (Cambridge or West African) with credits in English Language and four other subjects allied to the proposed course of study. Equivalent qualifications gained through the General Certificate of Education will be accepted.

7. *Other qualifications.*—(a) Applications may be made by candidates of either sex who must be under 30 years of age on 1st January, 1962;

(b) successful candidates will be required to pass a medical examination of fitness which will include a tuberculin test and an X-ray examination of the chest.

8. *Places of study.*—The majority of the awards will be for courses now available, either wholly or in part, at Colleges or Universities in Nigeria and in other countries in West Africa. Intending candidates MUST, therefore, acquaint themselves with the conditions of entry into these Institutions of Higher Learning and MUST THEMSELVES apply direct for admission to the institution of their choice. Candidates will be required to produce evidence of acceptance but NO guarantee of award can be given to every applicant who has been successful in obtaining entry to one of the West African Colleges or other Universities.

9. *Application forms.*—Application for scholarships must be completed in duplicate on the prescribed forms obtainable from:—

(a) The Federal Ministry of Education, Lagos.

(b) The Secretary, Northern Nigeria Scholarships Board, Kaduna.

(c) The Secretary, Eastern Nigeria Scholarships Board, Enugu.

(d) The Secretary, Western Nigeria Scholarships Board, Ibadan.

(e) The Nigerian High Commission (Students' Section), Nigeria House Annexe, The Adelphi, John Adam Street, London, W.C. 2.

(f) Consulate-General of Nigeria (Education Division), 575 Lexington Avenue, New York, 22 N.Y., U.S.A.

(g) Commissioner for Nigeria in Sierra Leone, Office of the Commissioner for Nigeria, Freetown, Sierra Leone.

(h) High Commissioner for Nigeria in Ghana, Office of the High Commissioner for Nigeria, P.O. Box 1548, Accra, Ghana.

10. *Submission of application.*—(i) Except in cases specified in sub-paragraphs (ii) and (iii) below, one copy of the completed forms—together with a passport-size photograph certified on the reverse side to be a true likeness of the applicant should be forwarded to the Permanent Secretary (Scholarship Section), Federal Ministry of Education, Lagos, so as to reach him on or before *Saturday, 14th April, 1962*. Envelopes should be marked "SCHOLARSHIPS" in the top left-hand corner. The second copy of the completed application forms should be sent to the College in West Africa where the applicant is seeking admission regardless of whether a previous application has been made to the College. If a candidate is applying to more than one institution extra copies should be completed and forwarded accordingly.

(ii) Applicants desiring to pursue courses which are only available outside West Africa should fill only one copy of the application form which should be despatched together with a PHOTOGRAPH as prescribed above to the Permanent Secretary (Scholarship Section), Federal Ministry of Education, Lagos.

(iii) Applications accompanied by a PHOTOGRAPH as explained above, from Nigerian Students in the United Kingdom and on the Continent of Europe should be forwarded in duplicate to the Education Attaché, Nigeria House Annexe, The Adelphi, John Adam Street, London, W.C. 2., so as to reach him not later than *Saturday, 14th April, 1962*. Private students in the United States of America and Canada should apply in the same way to the Nigerian Consulate-General (Education Division), 575 Lexington Avenue, New York, 22 New York, U.S.A. so as to reach him not later than *Saturday, 14th April, 1962*.

11. As already stated in paragraph 1 above, 200 of the 600 scholarships under category (ii) will be reserved for the Northern Region; also 100 of the 120 special university and other post-secondary scholarships will be for candidates from the Northern Region. Applications from candidates from the Northern Region should therefore be directed to the Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Education, Kaduna, Northern Nigeria. The Northern Region Scholarship Board will deal with these scholarships in general consultation with the Federal Ministry of Education. Special notices in respect of these awards will be published in due course. These special provisions for the Northern Region are in accord with the Federal Government's desire to "do everything possible to intensify the rate of educational development in the Northern Region".

12. *Warning.*—It is important that candidates adhere strictly to the foregoing instructions as failure to do so may lead to rejection of the application of the particular candidates concerned. No late applications will be entertained. All interested candidates should note that the number of potential scholars has increased in the past few years and so there is a very keen competition for these Federal Government Scholarship Awards. Candidates are therefore advised in their own interest to apply early and to receive in advance the permission of persons they wish to nominate as their referees. All recommenda-

tions of or reports by referees are expected to be received at the Federal Ministry of Education not later than 30th April, 1962.

POST-GRADUATE AWARDS

1. *Object.*—In order to meet Nigeria's urgent needs for research workers and university teachers the Federal Government proposes to award 120 post-graduate scholarships for each of the two years 1962/1963 and 1963/1964. These scholarships will be tenable in Nigerian universities as well as in universities and institutions of advanced studies abroad.

2. *Courses.*—Awards will be made for studies leading to Masters Degrees in Arts and Science and to Doctorate Degrees in Arts and Science, including Applied Science and Technology.

3. *Condition of awards.*—The following conditions must be satisfied before a candidate can be considered for an award:—

(a) The candidate must obtain a first or second class honours in his or her first degree.

(b) The field of post-graduate study or research must be approved by the Federal Ministry of Education after necessary consultations with other parties concerned.

(c) The candidate must be satisfactorily recommended by at least two university professors competent to do so.

(d) There must be proof that the candidate is already admitted or admissible into a post-graduate school.

(e) There must be a guarantee that the candidate will serve in a Nigerian University or in any other appropriate post on the successful completion or on the determination of his or her post-graduate studies or research.

(f) The candidate must subscribe to an agreement setting out the manner of his or her employment after the successful completion of the course. In general the candidate will be required to enter into bonds to serve as directed by the Federal Government.

4. *Qualifications.*—(i) Candidates must be graduates (first or second class honours);

(ii) candidates must be Nigerians (i.e. one or both of candidates' parents must be of Nigerian Nationality);

(iii) the scholarships are open to men and women;

(iv) there is no age restriction for these post-graduate awards.

5. *Application forms.*—There are no application forms, but intending candidates should apply in the form of formal letters supported by strong

recommendations of the candidates' professors as stated under paragraph 3 (c) and accompanied by a certificate of admission by an approved university.

6. *Submission of applications.*—All applications for post-graduate scholarships should be addressed to the Permanent Secretary, Federal Ministry of Education, Lagos, NIGERIA. Applications may be submitted at any time between now and 30th September, 1962. Subject to the availability of suitable candidates 120 awards will be made during the year 1962-1963.

(j) No correspondence on the results of the examination will be entered into, and no interviews will be granted. Improper attempts to influence

members of the College Staff regarding the admission of any candidate will result in the disqualification of the candidate on behalf of whom the attempt is made.

This post forms part of the Geneva establishment of the I.L.O. but the successful candidate may be required to work at any duty station to which he or she may be assigned by the Director-General of the International Labour Office.

Description of work.—Under appropriate supervision:

1. To abstract and compile information on social and economic problems affecting non-manual workers (salaried employees and professional workers).
2. To analyse such information and to present it in a form suitable for inclusion in I.L.O. Studies and Reports.
3. To draft reports, studies and other papers for use within the Office or for publication.
4. To draft reports on the application of ratified conventions (Article 22 of the Constitution).

Qualifications required.—(1) *Nationality.*—Cameroon, Central African Republic, Chad, Congo (Brazzaville), Dahomey, Gabon, Guinea, Ivory Coast, Liberia, Libya, Malagasy Republic, Mali, Mauritania, Niger, Nigeria, Somalia, Sudan, Upper Volta.

(2) *Age.*—On the closing date for the receipt of applications, candidates should not be less than 23 (born before 1st April, 1939) and not more than 35 (born after 30th March, 1927).

(3) Fully satisfactory knowledge of English or French, including ability to draft; knowledge of other languages would be an additional qualification.

(4) Preferably university degree in law and/or economics, or at least equivalent experience.

Examination.—Candidates selected by the Board of Examiners may be required to undergo an examination.

Salary.—The salary scale of an Assistant Member of Division is \$4,800 (minimum) rising by eight annual increments to a maximum of \$6,130. The

initial salary of the person appointed will be fixed in accordance with his experience and qualifications. Salaries are adjusted according to changes in price levels; an annual upward adjustment ranging from \$144 to \$288 is at present paid at Geneva. Family allowances of \$400 in respect of a dependent spouse and \$300 in respect of each child, and an education grant of up to \$400 a year are payable.

Salaries are free from Swiss income tax; any other income taxes levied on official emoluments will be reimbursed in accordance with rules laid down by the Director-General.

The post is a permanent one, but the appointment will be made in the first instance for a period of one year, which will be considered as a period of probation.
