*Duties.*—Successful candidates may be required to serve either in the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Commonwealth Relations in Lagos as Assistant Secretaries or in any of the offices or establishments maintained by the Federal Government overseas, and frequent transfers may be necessary in the early years of service. Duties will include all types of work undertaken in these offices, such as normal diplomatic duties, promotion of Nigeria's trade and economic development, information, the welfare of students, the welfare of pilgrims, labour matters and general administrative duties. After appointment and during a probationary period officers may be required to undergo a course of training, the type and length of which may vary in accordance with the previous experience of the individual officer. Officers may be required to pass an examination in one foreign language, and will be given the opportunity, during the period of training, to study it.

*Other conditions of service.*—Selected candidates who are not already in one of the four Public Services will be appointed to the Federal Public Service as Assistant Secretaries in Scale A on probation for a period of three years. Officers serving in the Public Service of the Federation will be regarded as on trial for up to two years after which they may expect to make their career in the Foreign Service. Officers already serving in the Public Service of a Region may be either seconded or transferred during the same trial period of two years after which

they also may expect to make their career in the Foreign Service of the Public Service of the Federation. While in Nigeria the terms of service will be the same as those of other Administrative Officers of the Federal Public Service. While serving overseas an officer will receive the following allowances which are non-pensionable:

(i) A Clothing Allowance on three occasions during his career. (The rate of this allowance is £180 for a married officer and £120 for a single officer).

(ii) A Disturbance and Resettlement Allowances on posting from Nigeria to an overseas post, on transfer from one overseas post to another and on final return to Nigeria. (The rate of this allowance is 10 per cent of basic salary up to a limit of £150 for married officers, and 5 per cent of basic salary up to a limit of £100 for single officers).

(iii) An Overseas Allowance. This allowance is paid to officers to compensate them for the local cost of living and for expenditure which they must by necessity incur as representatives of Nigeria serving overseas. The rates of the allowance vary according to an officer's rank and the overseas post in which he is serving.

(iv) Rent Supplement. If an officer is not occupying accommodation owned or leased by Government, he is granted a Rent Supplement to enable him to rent suitable accommodation.

*Method of application.*—Applications should be addressed to the Secretary, Federal Public Service Commission, Private Mail Bag 12586, Lagos, so as to reach him not later than the 24th July, 1962. Applications from candidates not in Government Service should be completed in duplicate on the prescribed form which may be obtained from all Administrative Officers in charge of Provinces and Divisions; from the Director, Information Division, Ministry of Information, Lagos; and from the Regional Ministries of Information, Ibadan, Kaduna and Enugu.

Applicants in the United Kingdom may obtain the prescribed forms from the Recruitment Secretary in the Office of the High Commissioner for Nigeria, 9 Northumberland Avenue, London, W.C.2, to whom completed forms should be returned; those in the United States, from the Nigerian Embassy, 500 Dupon Circle Building, Washington 6, D.C.; and similarly from the Nigerian Embassy, High Commission or Commission in those countries where they are established. The completed forms from candidates in all these countries, except the United Kingdom, should be sent direct to the Secretary, Federal Public Service Commission, Lagos.

Applications from candidates in Government Service should be submitted through the Head of the applicant's Department and the Secretary of the Public Service Commission concerned, and should be accompanied by a Confidential Report on the prescribed form.
