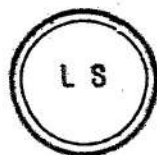

WHEREAS by subsection (2) of section 115 of the Constitution of the Federation of Nigeria it is provided that the Judges of the High Court of Lagos shall be a Chief Justice of Lagos and such number of other Judges (not being less than five) as may be prescribed by Parliament.

AND WHEREAS it is provided by subsection (1) (as amended) of section 4 of the High Court of Lagos Act, Cap. 80 of the Laws of the Federation of Nigeria, that the number of Judges of the High Court of Lagos, in addition to the Chief Justice, shall be eight.

AND WHEREAS the number of Judges of the High Court of Lagos is now six, in addition to the Chief Justice.

AND WHEREAS it is provided by subsection (2) of section 116 of the Constitution of the Federation that the Judges of the High Court of Lagos shall be appointed by the Governor-General acting in accordance with the advice of the Judicial Service Commission of the Federation.

NOW THEREFORE, I, NNAMDI AZIKIWE, Member of Her Majesty's Most Honourable Privy Council, Governor-General and Commander-in-Chief of the Federation of Nigeria, do hereby, in accordance with the advice of the Judicial Service Commission of the Federation, appoint JOSEPH ADETUNJI ADEFARASIN to be an acting Judge of the High Court of Lagos with effect from the first day of August, 1962.

GIVEN under my hand and the Public Seal of the Federation of Nigeria at State House, Lagos, this twenty-eighth day of July, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-two.

## APPLICATION FOR AN OIL PIPELINE LICENCE

5. Matters relating to the amount of compensation payable by the aforesaid Company for its use of land affected shall not be material grounds to include in a notice of objection.

6. The Administrative Officer in-charge of Ahoada Division shall enquire into objections (if any) duly lodged in accordance with paragraphs 3 and 4 above at his office at Ahoada, at 10 a.m. on the 20th day of September, 1962, giving all parties an opportunity to be heard, and reports thereof shall be sent without delay to the Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Mines and Power, Lagos, for submission to the Minister who shall advise whether or not the Licence shall be granted.

7. Compensation (if any) payable by the aforesaid Company for its use of the land affected shall be determined by negotiation between the Company and the landowners and occupiers.

## 1962-63 COCOA MARKETING SCHEME: MINIMUM BUYING STATION PRICES

It is notified for general information that the Western Region Marketing Board, by virtue of its powers under section 16 (a) of the Marketing Board Law (Cap. 75 of the Laws of the Western Region of Nigeria, 1959), has fixed the prices set out in columns II and III of the Schedule subjoined as the minimum prices payable for cocoa during the 1962-63 season at gazetted buying stations in the Western Region specified in column I.

2. The minimum buying station prices are based on the naked ex-scale port of shipment prices fixed by the Board for the 1962-63 season less the transport differentials by the approved evacuation routes.

## PRODUCE SALES TAX

3. Under the provisions of the Western Region Produce Sales Tax Law (Cap. 99 of the Laws of the Western Region of Nigeria, 1959), all sales of cocoa made in the Western Region to the licensed buying agents of the Western Region Marketing Board are subject to produce sales tax at the rate of £4 per ton.

4. For purposes of collection of this tax, for which under the Western Region Produce Sales Tax Law, 1957, the Marketing Board is accountable to the appropriate regional authority in respect of all sales of cocoa made to it or to its licensed buying agents in the Region the arrangements as set out in paragraph 5 are prescribed.

5. The prices payable by the licensed buying agents of the Marketing Board for cocoa in the Western Region will take into account the incidence of produce sales tax and will accordingly be at the rates set out in columns IV and V of the Schedule subjoined (being the minimum buying station prices fixed by the Marketing Board reduced by the amount of produce sales tax).

Spraying operations are to be carried out on roosting sites during the months of January to March and on nesting sites from August to November inclusive.

(3) The aircraft will be required to operate from local landing strips constructed near the spraying sites where supplies of fuels and oils will be arranged by the Government on a repayment basis.

(4) Spraying operations on roosting sites will be carried out at dusk but nesting sites will be sprayed during day light hours.

(5) The contracting Company will be required to supply a two way ground to air radio for spraying control.

(6) In addition to spraying the aircraft may be required for reconnaissance duties for spotting roosting and nesting sites.

(7) The pilots accommodation and subsistence will be the responsibility of the Government at Maiduguri and while living under bush conditions during spraying operations.

(8) Adequate medical facilities will be available and all precautions as recommended by the Toxicology Research Unit of the Medical Research Council and other Research Organisations who have contributed to this subject will be observed.

(9) The contracting company will however be required to ensure that the cockpit of the aircraft is secured against penetration of spraymist and to supply goggles for the pilot as an added precaution.

(10) The pilot will not be required to handle parathion, fill the spray tanks, clean the aircraft or flush tanks, but will be required to be fully conversant with decontamination requirements of the aircraft and equipment and the precaution necessary in handling parathion.

(11) A minimum of 250 hours flying time will be guaranteed during the total period in which control measures are undertaken but it is expected that it will be in excess of this time.
