NIGER DELTA DEVELOPMENT BOARD

VACANCY FOR FISHERIES OFFICER

Applications are invited from suitably qualified Nigerian candidates for the post of Fisheries Officer in the service of the Niger Delta Development Board. The Board is charged under the constitution of the Federation with undertaking a survey of the Niger Delta Area in order to ascertain what measures are required to promote its physical development and with the preparation of schemes designed to promote that development. The Constitution also provides that the life of the Board shall expire on the 1st July, 1969, unless extended by Parliament. The headquarters of the Board are sited at Port Harcourt.

Duties.—The Fisheries Officer will be required to undertake research and investigation, including the carrying out of a series of pilot projects throughout the Niger Delta area. Investigations will thus cover off-shore, fresh water and brackish water fishery. During the first three years of his appointment the officer would be required to work under the guidance of a Fisheries Expert appointed under technical assistance. At the end of that time, the Fisheries Officer may be required to take over full responsibility for this work.

Qualifications.—Applicants must possess a university honours degree in biology and preferably some experience in this field. It is desirable that they should be able to speak the Ijaw language fluently.

Conditions of service.—The salary of the post is at present in Scale A of the Federal Government (£720 to £1,584 per annum), the point of entry to be decided in relation to the age and experience of the successful applicant. The Board might be prepared to consider the payment of a higher starting salary in exceptional cases. Revision of the salary structure of the Board is at present under consideration.

The post will not be pensionable but the person appointed will be eligible to participate in a non-contributory provident fund scheme which the Board is in the process of establishing.

The other conditions of service are at present similar to those of members of the Federal Public Service of equivalent rank.
