REVOCATION OF INSTRUMENT OF TEMPORARY AUTHORITY TO PERFORM
FUNCTIONS OF PRIME MINISTER



By His Excellency the Right Honourable Dr NNAMDI AZIKIWE, Member of Her Majesty's Most Honourable Privy Council, Governor-General and Commander-in-Chief of the Federation of Nigeria.

WHEREAS, by an Instrument given under my hand and the Public Seal of the Federation of Nigeria on the 20th day of May, 1963, Alhaji the Honourable MUHAMMADU RIBADU, M.B.E., M.P., was temporarily authorised to perform sundry functions conferred upon the Prime Minister by the Constitution of the Federation of Nigeria during the absence of the Prime Minister from Nigeria :

AND WHEREAS the Prime Minister returned to Nigeria on the 26th day of May, 1963 :

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 85 of the Constitution of the Federation of Nigeria, I, NNAMDI AZIKIWE, Governor-General of the Federation of Nigeria, in accordance with the advice of the Prime Minister hereby revoke with effect from the 26th day of May, 1963, the Instrument of Temporary Authority given under my hand and the Public Seal of the Federation of Nigeria on the 20th day of May, 1963, as aforesaid.
