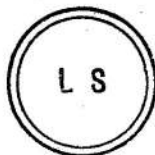

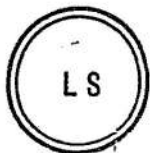

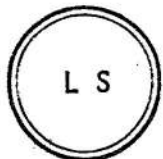

## NOTICE BY THE BOARD OF CUSTOMS AND EXCISE

Customs and Excise Notice No. 35

CUSTOMS CONTROL OF APPROVED WHARVES, CUSTOMS AREAS, EXAMINATION STATIONS, SHIPS,  
AIRCRAFT AND VEHICLES

Commencement : 1st September, 1963

*Notes.*—1. This Notice deals only with the control over vehicles, animals, small craft and goods. Information regarding the control over persons entering Approved Wharves, Customs Areas and Examination Stations, or boarding ships or aircraft is contained in Customs and Excise Notice No. 3 published as Government Notice No. 1295 of 1963 in the Official Gazette No. 44 of 27th June, 1963.

2. In this Notice the expression "Restricted Area" means an Approved Wharf, Customs Area or Examination Station.

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Board of Customs and Excise by sections 13, 15, 18, and 69 of the Customs and Excise Management Act, (No. 55 of 1958) and by the Small Craft (Customs Licensing) Regulations, 1959 (Legal Notice No. 147 of 1959), it is hereby notified that the conditions under which vehicles, animals and small craft may enter or leave a Restricted Area and under which goods may be taken into or removed from a Restricted Area, ship or aircraft are as stated herein.

2. *Entry into a Restricted Area.*—No vehicle, animal or small craft may enter, nor may any goods be carried into a Restricted Area except :—

- (a) vehicles, animals and goods intended to be lawfully loaded into a ship, aircraft or vehicle ;
- (b) vehicles and animals carrying goods intended to be lawfully loaded into a ship, aircraft or vehicle, or carrying persons duly authorised or exempted under Customs and Excise Notice No. 3 ;
- (c) vehicles carrying persons whose services the proper Officer is satisfied are urgently required for the safety or preservation of life or property ;
- (d) small craft (*i.e.*, ships not exceeding one hundred tons register) which, either :—
  - (i) belong to, and are in the service of, the Government, the Nigerian Ports Authority or a ship which is lying within the port ; or
  - (ii) are licensed by the Board.

Such small craft may operate only under such conditions as the proper Officer may impose.

3. *Vehicles.*—No vehicle having any concealed compartment or any compartment which is not readily accessible shall be permitted to be used for carrying goods in a Restricted Area.

4. *Small Craft.*—(a) No small craft, other than those referred to in sub-paragraph 2 (d), shall go or remain alongside or approach within fifty yards of any aircraft or ship.

(b) Applications for licences for small craft should be made to the proper Collector of Customs and Excise. Licences expire on 31st December of the year of issue and are subject to a fee of £1. A separate licence must be obtained for each small craft.

(c) Any small craft licensed by the Board shall have conspicuously exhibited thereon a mark and number assigned by the Board.

(d) Small craft must be so constructed that they are fitted with hatch covers capable of being locked or sealed. Only in exceptional circumstances will licences be issued in respect of small craft which do not comply with this requirement.

(e) The Board reserves the right to cancel at any time, without assigning any reason, any licence issued under this paragraph.

(f) Nothing in this notice will absolve the owner from complying with the provisions of any other law relating to the licensing of small craft.

5. *Use of most direct Route.*—Any vehicle, animal or goods in a Restricted Area shall proceed or be transported between one place and another by the most direct route without calling at any places other than those at which business is to be transacted.

6. *Limitation on Movements.*—The movements of any animal, ship, aircraft, vehicle, small craft or goods authorised to be in a Restricted Area shall be limited to such places as are necessary for business to be transacted.

7. *Unauthorised Landing of Goods.*—No goods shall be landed from an aircraft or ship except such goods as are allowed to be landed under the Customs and Excise laws, and in accordance with any condition imposed for such landing. All goods landed must be taken to the proper place appointed within a Customs Area for the deposit of such goods and must be produced to the proper Officer of Customs and Excise. Failure to comply with these requirements renders an offender liable, under sections 43 and 44 of the Customs and Excise Management Act No. 55 of 1958, to a fine of six times the value of the goods or two hundred pounds, whichever is the greater, and to the forfeiture of the goods.

(b) *Containers*—(i) *Palm Kernels*—"B" Twill Bags will be supplied to licensed buying agents by the Board. Applicants must however produce evidence of ability to provide sufficient twine to cover at least the minimum purchase requirement.

(ii) *Palm Oil*—Applicants must show that they possess enough drums/casks to cover the minimum purchase requirements.

(c) *Capital*—Applicants will be required to produce acceptable evidence of their ability to provide the necessary capital to finance their purchases. Buying agents have to be in a position to buy at not less than minimum prices at gazetted buying stations and to arrange for the produce to be evacuated to port (in the case of palm kernels) or Bulk Oil Plant (in the case of palm oil), at which point payment is made against delivery of the produce in the approved manner.

(d) *Storage*—Applicants must be able to provide evidence that they have available in their proposed areas of operation proper storage to cover at least two hundred tons of palm kernels, and adequate port storage where appropriate.

All stores must comply with the requirements of, and be approved by, the Western Region Produce Inspection Service. It is the responsibility of the applicant to request in writing the Produce Officer of the area concerned to inspect and approve his store.

(e) *General*—An applicant must be prepared to produce satisfactory evidence to show that he is fully conversant with the produce trade in question and that in particular he will be able to fulfil the following conditions :—

(i) *Equipment*—That he possesses the required equipment for the grading of produce for export.

(ii) *Inspection of Produce*—That he will be able to provide grading equipment and an adequate labour force at all stores.

(iii) *Returns*—That he will render promptly and accurately all returns particularly as to purchases and stocks, which may be called for by the Board's executive.

(iv) *Evacuation*—That he will be able to make arrangements to secure the necessary transport by road, rail and water to ensure the smooth and regular evacuation of produce by approved routes.

(v) *Delivery*—That he can arrange delivery of palm oil to the appropriate Bulk Oil Plant and of palm kernels to Board Store, Apapa, or to f.o.b. on board ocean vessel. In the case of palm kernels delivered to f.o.b., he must possess the organisation at port or the ability to secure reliable agents to ensure the accurate preparation and prompt submission of shipping documents as required and the carrying out of all duties involved in the delivery of palm kernels to f.o.b. point.

## 4. METHOD OF APPLICATION
