 - (ii) a foolscap (9" x 4") envelope, to which a 3d stamp is affixed, bearing the applicant's name and postal address and marked "C & G" at the lower left hand corner.
- 3. No letter should accompany the application. Entry forms for any previous examinations of the Institute should not be used.
- 4. The Examinations will be held at the following Centres:—

ABA, ENUGU, IBADAN, KADUNA, KANO, LAGOS, PORT HARCOURT, WARRI, SAPELE, IJEBU-ODE, OSHOGBO, MINNA, BUKURU, AND BURUTU.

- 5. Completed entry forms should be returned to the West African Examinations Council, Yaba, Lagos, not later than 30th November, 1963. Late Entries will not be accepted.
- 6. The pamphlet containing the General Regulations for the examinations in 1964 is obtainable at 1s-3d per copy (post free), from the West African Examinations Council, Yaba, Lagos. Applications for the General Regulations should be made separately and not combined with the application for entry forms.
