#### CONSTITUTION OF THE FEDERATION

By His Excellency Doctor NNAMDI AZIKIWE, President and Commander-in-Chief of the Federal Republic of Nigeria.

## NNAMDI AZIKIWE,

President

Whereas by subsection (2) of section 111 of the Constitution of the Federation it is provided that the Judges of the Supreme Court shall be:—(a) the Chief Justice of Nigeria; (b) any such number of Justices of the Supreme Court (not being less than five) as may be prescribed by Parliament.

AND WHEREAS the number of Justices of the Supreme Court is now three in addition to the Chief Justice of Nigeria.

AND WHEREAS by subsection (4) of section 112 of the said Constitution of the Federation, it is further provided that if the office of any Justice of the Supreme Court is vacant the President may appoint a person qualified to hold the office of a Justice of the Supreme Court to act in the office of a Justice of the Supreme Court.

Now therefore, I, NNAMDI AZIKIWE, President and Commander-in-Chief of the Federal Republic of Nigeria, do hereby appoint Eugene Olufemi Adeyinka Morgan to act in the Office of a Justice of the Supreme Court as from the 7th day of October, 1963, and until further notice.

Give Vunder my hand and the Public Seal of the Federal Republic of Nigeria at State House, Lagos, this Eighteenth day of October, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-three.
