In order to avoid the uncertainties which accompanied the issue of import Licences on Japan this year, the following procedure will be adopted in processing applications for 1964 licences.

2. Importers of Japanese textiles are advised to :--

(i) collect new specific application forms from the Federal Ministry of Commerce and Industry, Lagos, or, if in the Regions from our offices at Kano, Jos, Port Harcourt, Onitsha, Aba, Calabar Ibadan, Sapele and Ondo;

(ii) complete application forms which must state requirements for the full year and should be returned to reach the officers-in-charge of the aforementioned stations by Wednesday 15th January, 1964;

(iii) note that supplementary applications and/ or applications received after 15th January, 1964 will not be entertained;

(iv) note that applications must be fully documented.

A satisfactory application must show the following :---

(a) particulars of the importer or applicant;

(b) details of his requirements for the full year as given in Legal Notice No. 105 of 22nd August, 1963;

(c) certified true statement showing particulars and value of imports of *the controlled goods* in the year 1962;

(d) particulars of Nigerian produce (if any) shipped to Japan in 1962 and/or 1963.

3. Importers are hereby warned that transfer of a licence is an offence. Any one wishing to transfer and/or import goods through an agent must show reasons for this and have his licence endorsed accordingly. Any attempt to transfer a licence other than as stated above will result in cancellation of the licence.

4. Importers are further warned against the possible danger of false declaration. The Ministry reserves the right to call for all original documents (including 1963 licences on Japan) in support of any claim made by applicants and any case of false declaration will be dealt with according to law. All applicants (including those who have applied earlier) are therefore required to apply on the new forms bearing honour certificates.

5. Lastly, it is essential that all applicants should satisfy the conditions set out above. The Ministry will not engage in correspondence with any applicant in respect of a faulty application. All applications must therefore be received by the closing dead-line. Thereafter, they will be considered and licences issued. The quota having then been exhausted, no supplementary or late applications will be countenanced.
