Public Lands Acquisition Act (Chapter 167)
Land meltirle for the Service of the Federal Goverfment
Notice is hereby given that all that parcel of land situate in the Federal Territory of Lagos and known as Olowogbowo, Lagos, the Federal Capital of Nigeria containing an area of approximately 28.21 acres, the boundaries of which are described below is required by the President of the Federal Republic of Nigeria for public purposes absolutely and-in partieular for the second Approach Bridge.

## Description

Starting from a concrete Pillar P.B.L..S. 3914 by the Lagoon the Colony co-ordinates of which are 892,068.00 North $350,853.00$ East, except for the Lagoon shore nll, boundaries are in straight lines, the bearings and lengths of which are as follows:-

- Thence following the Shore of the Lagos Lagoon to P.B.L.S. 3914 the starting point.
: 2. All property beacons are concrete pillars, all bearings and lengths are approximate only and all bearings are referred to Colony North.

3. Any person claiming to have any right or interest in the said land is required within six weeks from the date of this Notice to send to the Minister of Lagos Affairs, care of the Permanent Secretary at his office in Lagos a statement of his right and interest and of the evidence thereof, and of any claim made by him in respect of such right or interest.
4." The President is willing to treat for the acquisition of the said land.
4. Land in respect of which no statement is receixed is liable to be dealt with ast unoccupied land.
5. And Notice is also hereby given that the President interds to enter iñto possession of the said land from the day following the publication of this Notice.
6. Any person who shall wilfully hinder or obstruct the President or any person employed by him from taking possession of the said land is liable under the provisions of the Act above-mentioned on conviction to a fine of twenty-five pounds or to imprisonment for three months.
