AMENDMENT No. 1

Customs and Excise Notice No. 10 published as Government Notice No. 699 in the Official Gazette No. 21 of 1st April, 1959, is hereby amended as follows:—

Paragraph 16. Delete the last two sentences" (The forms should be submitted........purposes only)" and insert new paragraph 16A:

"16A. Number of copies of Entries.

- (a) Entries are to be submitted in quadruplicate in the case of forms C.27 and C.30, and in quintuplicate in the case of form C.29.
