  - (f) to arrange for checkweighing and inspection at port in accordance with the regulations;
- (g) to arrange for delivery of cocoa to ocean going vessel or the Board's Stores, Apapa, and to Lat d without delay shipping documents as required to the Nigerian Produce Marketing Company Lamited

### 4. MINIMUM CONDITIONS

- (a) Purchases.—Applicants must produce evidence of ability to purchase with r asonable regularity throughout a season a minimum of 400 tons of cocoa li.e., Main and Light crops inclusive);
- (b) Bags and Traine.—"B"Twill bags will be supplied Licensed buying agents by the Board. Applicants must, however, produce evidence of ability to provide sufficient twine to cover at least the maximum purchase requirement.
- (c) Capital.—Applicants will be required to produce acceptable evidence of their ability to satisfy the minimum capital requirement accessary to fulfil the obligations of a licensed buying agent. The minimum capital requirement is £9,000.
