Oil Pipelines Act, 1956

APPLICATION FOR AN OIL PIPELINE LICENCE

NOTICE is hereby given in accordance with section 8 of the Oil Pipelines Act, 1956 that THE SHELL-BP PETROLEUM DEVELOPMENT COMPANY OF NIGERIA LIMITED has applied to the Minister of Mines and Power for the grant of a licence to enter upon, take possession of and use for 60 years a strip of land for the purpose of laying a 10-inch diameter welded steel oil pipeline from the Company's Olomoro Flowstation to a point on the aforesaid Company's 16-inch Eriemumu/Rumuekpe Oil Pipeline Wayleave, north-east of Olomoro Village in the Isoko Division of Mid-Western Nigeria in the Federal Republic of Nigeria, the route of which is demarcated on the ground by a survey trace marked with red stakes and is herein described.

DESCRIPTION

All that strip of land approximately $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles long situate within the Isoko Division of Mid-Western Nigeria in the Federal Republic of Nigeria, the centre-line of which traverses dry land and swamp and is shown hatched in black in the aforesaid Company's Plan No. 8348A, dated September 1964.

The width of the said strip of land will be variable and will be approximately as follows:—

- (a) where the route of the centre-line traverses dry land and seasonal swamp—50 feet, except
- (b) where the route of the centre-line traverses existing public roads—10 feet.

The route of the centre-line is described as follows:—

Starting at a point in the Shell-BP Olomoro Flowstation, approximately 3 miles north-east of Olomoro Village, the route proceeds on a bearing of $157^{\circ} 19'$ for a distance of approximately $\frac{1}{4}$ mile within land occupied by the aforesaid Company under the terms of Oil Mining Lease No. 30 to a point (marked ER 36 on the plan) and thence on a bearing of $214^{\circ} 46'$ for a distance of 7844 feet to a point approximately $\frac{1}{4}$ mile north-west of a point (marked P 13 35) on the aforesaid Company's Eriemumu/Rumuekpe Oil Pipeline Wayleave approximately $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles north-east of Olomoro Village.

The bearings and lengths are approximate and the bearings refer to Colony Grid North.

The oil pipeline will be buried approximately 30 inches under the surface of the dry land and swamp.

2. A copy of a Plan of the pipeline route identifying the land affected can be inspected during all normal working hours at the Ministry of Lands and Housing, Benin City; the Federal Ministry of Mines and Power, Lagos; the Divisional Office, Ughelli, and the Office at Umuobiakani, near Port Harcourt, of the aforesaid Company.

3. Any person who considers that his land or interest in land will be injuriously affected by the grant of the licence should lodge orally or in writing within three weeks from the date of this notice with the Ministry of Lands and Housing, Benin City, notice of objection stating the interest of the objector and the grounds of objection.

4. Any public officer who receives a verbal objection in the course of his duties shall record the name and address, interest and grounds of objection of any person lodging such a verbal objection and shall forward such details to the Ministry of Lands and Housing, Benin City.

5. Matters relating to the amount of compensation payable by the aforesaid Company for its use of the land affected shall not be material grounds to include in a notice of objection.

6. The Ministry of Lands and Housing, Benin City, shall enquire into objections (if any) duly lodged in accordance with paragraphs 3 and 4 above at the office at Benin City at 11 a.m. on the 21st day of December, 1964, giving all parties an opportunity to be heard, and reports thereof shall be sent without delay to the Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Mines and Power, Lagos for submission to the Minister who shall decide whether or not the licence shall be granted.

7. Compensation (if any) payable by the aforesaid Company for its use of the land affected shall be determined by negotiation between the Company and the landowners and occupiers.

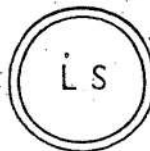
