NOTICE BY THE BOARD OF CUSTOMS-AND EXCISE

Customs and Excise Notice No. 16

AMENDMENT No. 8

Customs and Excise Notice No. 16, published as Government Notice No. 704 of 21st April, 1959, is hereby amended as follows:—

1. Insert the following as Part V-

"Part V—Industrial Development (Import Duties Relief) Act, 1957 CLAIMS FOR REPAYMENT OF DUTIES PAID"

- 45. General.—The method of applying for relief under the Industrial Development (Import Duties Relief) Act 1957, is explained in Government Notices 2051 and 2052 of 1957, published in Official Gazette No. 62 of 14th November, 1957. For the guidance of beneficieries, the following paragraphs set out the requirements of the Board of Customs and Excise as regards documentation, storage of goods and method of claiming repayments.
- 46. Importation and entry.—Materials for which relief has been authorised by the President are to be entered on importation in the normal way, an extra copy of the entry prominently headed in red ink, "For Import Duty Relief purposes only", being submitted. Each copy of the entry is to bear a declaration signed by the beneficiary to the effect that the goods will be used in accordance with the authority granted by the President and that import duty relief will be claimed.
- 47. Storage.—Both the materials on which relief is to be claimed and the products manufactured from them are to be stored separately from other goods, pending use or disposal.
- 48. Records.—Full records of both the receipt and disposal of all materials on which relief is to be claimed, and the goods made therefrom are to be kept. No set form of records is laid down since it is intended to make as much use as possible of a beneficiary's own records, but recommendations for approval of claims will not be made until the records kept by the beneficiary have been inspected and approved by the proper officer.

- 49. Use of authorised materials. -(a) ()nly the following materials qualify for relief :-
 - (i) Materials imported by a beneficiary and used in the manner authorised;
 - (ii) Unusable waste destroyed in the presence of the proper officer;
- (b) There is no objection to the use for other purposes of imported materials upon which relief has been authorised provided:—
 - (i) prior notice of such alternative use is given to the proper officer;
 - (ii) use and disposal is clearly shown in a beneficiary's records;
 - (iii) claim for relief is not made in respect of the materials so used.
- 50. Officer's right of entry to Beneficiary's Premises.—(a) The proper officer may at all reasonable time enter a beneficiary's premises and make such enquiries and examine such goods, processes, books and records as he deems necessary for the purpose of verifying claims for relief. He may also take such samples of materials or goods as he considers necessary for the proper verification of any claim.
- (b) A beneficiary or any person materially interested in the goods is to answer all questions put to him by the proper officer and produce all goods, books, records and other documents on demand. The responsibility for satisfying the officer that the terms of the President's authority have been carried out in full and that the relief can therefore be recommended, rests with the beneficiary.
- · -51. Method of claiming relief .-
 - (a) Form of claim and by whom to be made.—Claims for relief are to be submitted in triplicate on special forms which can be obtained from any Custom House or from the Secretary to the Board, and are to be completed by the person, persons or body named in the President's authority.
 - (b) When and where claims to be submitted.—Claims for relief are not to be made at intervals of less than three months. They are to be submitted to the Chief Collector of the Area where the industry is situated.
- 52. Penalties.—The attention of beneficiaries is invited to regulation 15 of the Industrial Development (Import Duties Relief) Regulations, 1957—Legal Notice 155 of 1957—which prescribes £500 as penalty in addition to any action which may be taken for false declaration or statement in connection with any application, return or claim for relief.
- 53. Board's right to vary requirements. The Board reserves the right to vary the general requirements of this notice to meet the special needs of individual cases.
