HYBRIDIZATION NAPLES, ITALY  
9-28 MAY, 1966

Organized by the International Laboratory of Genetics and Biophysics, Naples, under the auspices of U.N.E.S.C.O. and I.C.R.O.

A course on DNA-RNA hybridization will be held from 9-28 May at the International Laboratory of Genetics and Biophysics, Naples, Italy. The primary purpose of the Course will be to acquaint the participants with the detailed techniques employed in the formation, detection, and quantitative assay of DNA-RNA hybrids. The students will use molecular hybridization to examine for sequence homologies and to estimate genome proportions reserved for various specific genetic purposes.

Experiments, designed to detect natural DNA-RNA hybrids which occur as intermediates in both in vivo and in vitro transcription, will also be performed. Seminars and discussions will complement the practical work and a number of leading specialists will deliver lectures on special topics.

The number of participants is limited to 16. As a rule, only postgraduate students in the fields of mathematics, physics, chemistry, and biology will be accepted. The language of the Course will be English.

Six fellowships (which will cover travel expenses from place of residence to Naples and return, plus living expenses for the duration of the Course) will



be offered by the International Cell Research Organization under UNESCO sponsorship. Ten fellowships covering only living expenses for the duration of the Course will be offered by the Laboratory. Admittance to the Course and assignment of the fellowships will be based on the qualifications of the applicants. The teaching staff will review the applications and decide upon admittance to the Course.
