REBATE ON STUDENTS AIR PASSAGE

It is notified for general information that the Nigeria Airways in consultation with the Federal Ministry of Education is prepared to make a concessional rebate of 35 per cent on their air passage between Nigeria and Britain to students during the peak period of student departures to Britain for courses of studies. This period is from 1st of June to 30th September.

2. To be entitled to this rebate, a student Must be a government scholar, i.e., one who has been awarded a government scholarship to study overseas, or a government sponsored student, i.e., one who has been recommended to study overseas by either the Federal or any of the Regional Students Advisory Committee. Students when presenting themselves

for air rebate forms must produce evidence that they belong to one or the other of these categories.

- 3. The rebate form issued to a student must be handed to the Nigeria Airways. On no account should the form be made available to any other Airlines.
- 4. Students are also warned against the activities of some unscrupulous Travel Agents who elect to book students' passage for them. Experience of the past years has revealed that some students have had their flights deferred to the embarrassment of those students and their relations because Travel Agents failed to book their passage according to the schedule. It will, therefore, be in their interest if students collect the rebate forms themselves and book their passage direct with the Nigeria Airways.
