# FREE PRIMARY EDUCATION—1966 REGISTRATION OF ELIGIBLE CHILDREN

In accordance with the provisions of the Education (Lagos) Act 1958, the Chief Education Officer (Primary Education) in the Ministry of Education Lagos in liaison with the Chief Education Officer in the Lagos City Council are authorised to conduct the registration of children of primary school age, in 1966, within the Capital Territory of Lagos.
