THE UNITED STATES HEALTH SERVICE

Applications are invited from suitably qualified Nigerians for International Postdoctoral Fellowships for 1967. The fellowships are sponsored by the National Institute of Health, Bethesda, U.S.A. and are intended to provide foreign biomedical scientists, in the formative stages of their careers, with the opportunity to acquire specialized research training in the United States.

To be eligible, an applicant must have

(i) degree of Doctor of Philosophy (Ph. D.), Doctor of Medicine (M.D.), Doctor of Dental Surgery (D.D.S.), Doctor of Veterinary Medicine (D.V.M.) or an equivalent degree (e.g., M.B., Ch.B., B.D.S., etc.) in the health science field;

(ii) proficiency in the use of the English language, both written and spoken;

(iii) evidence of aptitude and promise in basic science or clinical research, with an active interest in pursuing a research career in the health science field;

(iv) a meritorious plan for specialized research training, which is clearly and explicitly presented;

(v) commitment or assurance from an institution or a Nominating Committee of a position in the home country, upon completion of the training in the United States, in which the fellow will be able to do research and use the experience gained during his fellowship;

(vi) affiliation with a preceptor. It is the applicant's responsibility to arrange for his research training with the preceptor under whom he will train; and

(vii) acceptance by a training institution.

The fellowships are awarded normally for a period of not less than 6 and not more than 12 continuous months and are tenable in research in Universities or research institutes in the United States of America: They may be extended for up to 24 months in cases which are adequately justified.

The values of the fellowship are \$5,000, \$5,500 and \$6,000 a year depending on the extent of the Fellow's relevant post-doctoral experience. Research experience (including industrial, teaching, internship, residency, etc.) may be considered relevant experience. The fellowship also covers allowances for dependants at the rate of \$500 for each dependant listed in the fellow's application whether or not they accompany the fellow to the training institution.

Further particulars will be supplied only to those applicants who, in the opinion of the Chairman of the Fellowship Nominating Committee for Nigeria, fulfils the conditions for eligibility stated above.

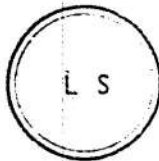
