## NOTES

(1) Item 41 South East Ikoyi ; Items 42, 43 and 44 Victoria Island ; Item 45 (2) Street Lighting and Item 46 Ijora Site Development are being carried out by the Board as agents of the Nigerian Federal Government who pay the contractors, etc., direct.
