All persons concerned are required therefore to notify the Board before disposing of any such goods, and to consult the Secretary to the Board, or the nearest Collector of Customs and Excise, where there is any doubt as to the interpretation of the customs and excise laws in relation to such goods.
 - 5. Government Notice 2324 of 1965 is hereby cancelled.
