Applications are invited from suitably qualified candidates for admission to the Federal School of Radiography in October, 1967, for a three-year course leading to Membership Diploma of the Society of Radiographers, London.

- 2. Qualification.—(i) A candidate must have a West African School Certificate with credits in five subjects including: English Language or English Literature, Mathematics, Two Science subjects, preferably Chemistry and Physics on General Certificate of Education with passes in five subjects including: English Literature or English Language, Mathematics, Two Science subjects preferably, Chemistry and Physics on Certificate of proficiency for X-Ray Technicians.
- (ii) Candidate must not be less than 18 years of age in October, 1967.
