THE CONSTITUTION OF THE FEDERATION

As modified by the Constitution (Suspension and Modification) Decree 1967



By His Excellency Lieutenant-Colonel YAKUBU GOWON, Head of the Federal Military Government, Commander-in-Chief of the Armed Forces of the Federal Republic of Nigeria.

Whereas by section 111 (1) of the Constitution of the Federation as modified by the Constitution (Suspension and Modification) Decree 1967 it is provided that the Judges of the Supreme Court of Nigeria shall consist of the Chief Justice of Nigeria and any such number of Justices of the Supreme Court (not being less than five) as may be prescribed by law:

AND WHEREAS the number of Justices of the Supreme Court is now nine in addition to the Chief Justice

of Nigeria:

AND WHEREAS by section 112 (1) of the Constitution of the Federation as modified by the Constitution (Suspension and Modification) Decree 1967 it is provided that the Chief Justice of Nigeria and the Justices of the Supreme Court shall be appointed by the Supreme Military Council:

Now Therefore, The Supreme Military Council, do hereby appoint Sir Lionei. Brett to act as the Chief Justice of Nigeria with effect from the 23rd day of March, 1967.
