The Government of Trinidad and Tobago has received a loan from the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development toward the cost of the Southern Highway Project. The proposed project involves the construction of a four-lane divided controlled access highway, approximately 14 miles long between Chase Village (Chaguanas) and St. Joseph Village (San Fernando). The four separate construction contracts intended for award are as follows:

Contract No. 1—5.5 miles long, from East of Chase Village to East of Couva, with reinforced concrete and steel highway bridges.

Contract No. 2—4.2 miles long, from East of Couva to East of St. Margaret, with reinforced concrete and steel highway bridges.

Contract No. 3—4.5 miles long, from East of St. Margaret to St. Joseph Village, with reinforced concrete and steel bridges.

Contract No. 4—14.2 miles long, from East of Chase Village to St. Joseph Village, for gravel base and asphalt concrete pavement for a two-lane carriageway only.

2. The Government of Trinidad and Tobago proposes to invite bids concurrently in the near future for Contracts Nos. 1, 2 and 3 which provide for the construction of the highway project, except for the gravel base and asphalt concrete pavement for one two-lane carriageway. Firms may apply for prequalification for one, or two or all of the above Contracts Nos. 1, 2 and 3. A firm which has prequalified for one or two of such contracts may submit bids for each or any of the said three contracts but will not be awarded a greater number of contracts than the number for which it has prequalified.

The time for construction to completion is 30 months, plus an additional 12 months guarantee period. Maximum use of indigenous labour, locally manufactured and/or assembled materials, and locally available construction plant and equipment is desirable.

3. It is expected that bids for Contract No. 4 will be invited approximately six months prior to the completion of Contracts Nos. 1, 2 and 3, and a separate prequalification will be made for this contract.

4. In prequalifying firms, the following will be considered:

- experience in similar highway and bridge construction;
- equipment, plant, and personnel available for use on the project works;
- financial position; and
- other works currently under execution.

5. 6. It is anticipated that prequalified firms will be invited to submit bids in October 1967, that bids will be received in December 1967, and that the contracts will be awarded in January 1968.

7. All bids will be opened and the total amount of each bid will be read on a date which will be specified. Members of tendering firms may attend the opening of bids.

8. Award of the contracts will be made on the basis of the lowest evaluated bids, either for all three contracts by one firm, or by a combination of contracts by different firms whichever results in the lowest total cost.

8. Applications from candidates in Government Service should be submitted through the applicant's Head of Department and the Secretary to the Public Service Commission concerned and be accompanied by a confidential report on the Confidential Report Form.

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
