WHEREAS it is necessary and expedient to fill the vacancy as Governor of the Central Bank of Nigeria caused by the resignation of Alhaji Aliyu Mai Bornu:

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 9 (1) of the Central Bank Act 1958, as modified by the Constitution (Suspension and Modification) Decree 1966 and the Constitution (Miscellaneous Provisions) (No. 2) Decree 1967, and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I, Major-General YAKUBU GOWON, Head of the Federal Military Government and Commander-in-Chief of the Armed Forces hereby appoint CLEMENT NYONG ISONG, Ph.D. as the Governor of the Central Bank of Nigeria, with effect from the 15th day of August, 1967 upon and subject to the terms and conditions set out in a letter of offer of appointment dated the 19th day of August, 1967.
