THE CONSTITUTION OF THE MID-WESTERN STATE

AS MODIFIED BY THE CONSTITUTION (SUSPENSION AND MODIFICATION) DECREE 1966 AND THE STATES (CREATION AND TRANSITIONAL PROVISIONS) DECREE 1967

WHEREAS by section 48 (2) of the Constitution of Mid-Western State as modified by the Constitution (Suspension and Modification) Decree 1966 and the States (Creation and Transitional Provisions) Decree 1967 it is provided that the Judges of the High Court of Mid-Western State shall consist of the Chief Justice of Mid-Western State and any such number of other Judges (not being less than six) as may be prescribed by law:

AND WHEREAS by section 49 (3) of the Constitution of the Mid-Western State as modified by the Constitution (Suspension and Modification) Decree 1966 and the States (Creation and Transitional Provisions) Decree 1967 it is provided that if the Office of Chief Justice of the State is vacant or if the person holding the Office is for any reason unable to perform the functions of his Office, those functions shall be performed by such one of the other Judges of the High Court of the State as may be designated in that behalf by the Supreme Military Council acting after consultation with the Advisory Judicial Committee:

NOW THEREFORE, THE SUPREME MILITARY COUNCIL, acting after consultation with the Advisory Judicial Committee do hereby appoint MASON AMATOTSERO BEGHO to act as Chief Justice of the High Court of the Mid-Western State with effect from the 12th day of October, 1967.
