Central Bank (Currency Conversion) Decree 1967 (1967 No. 51)

TIME FIXED FOR CURRENCY CONVERSION

Notice is hereby given for the information of the public as follows:

- A new issue of currency notes has been arranged by the Central Bank of Nigeria and a conversion date in respect thereof has been fixed under the Central Bank (Currency Conversion) Decree 1967 as 3rd January 1968.
- 2. Notice is accordingly given that all currency notes issued by the Bank in the years 1959 and 1965 will, if presented to the Central Bank on or before 22nd January 1968, be replaced by the Bank by the new issue to the equivalent value.
- 3. This Notice is in substitution for Government Notice No. 2078 published in the Official Gazette Extraordinary No. 110, Vol. 54 of 30th December, 1967.
