1. Bachelor of Science in Agriculture (B.Sc. (Agric.)) in the Faculty of Agriculture.
2. Bachelor of Arts (B.A.) in the Faculty of Arts.
3. Bachelor of Arts in Education and Bachelor of Science in Education (B.A. (Educ.) and B.Sc. (Educ.)) in the Faculty of Education.
4. Bachelor of Laws (LL.B.) in the Faculty of Law.
5. Bachelor of Science in Social Sciences (B.Sc. (Soc. Sc.)) in the Faculty of Social Sciences (Formerly B.Sc. (Econ.)).
6. Bachelor of Science (B.Sc.) in the Faculty of Science.
7. Bachelor of Pharmacy (B.Pharm.) in the Faculty of Science.

Minimum Entrance requirements for direct entry.—Applicants for direct entry to Degree Courses are required to possess at least 2 Advanced Level passes in addition to at least 3 other Ordinary Level passes in the General Certificate of Education examinations. Passes at the Principal Standard in the Higher School Certificate examinations are regarded as equivalent to Advanced Level passes in the General Certificate of Education examinations.

The subjects must include English Language credit in the West African School Certificate or Ordinary Level pass in the General Certificate of Education.

Method of application.—Before submitting their applications, candidates should acquaint themselves with the NOTES ON ADMISSION that will be sent along with forms of application for admission or with the Departmental or Faculty requirements which are contained in the University Faculty Handbooks obtainable in the University Bookshop on the receipt of Postal Order of 3s (including postage) for the Faculties of Agriculture, Arts, Education, Law and Social Sciences and 4s (including postage) for the Faculty of Science, including Pharmacy.
