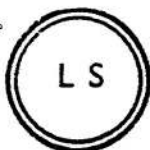

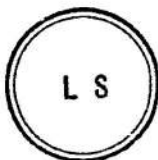

- productivity of education in the context of balanced educational development with a view to ensuring the harmonious co-ordination between educational principles and practice on the one hand and social and economic development on the other.
