1. That I am the Attorney to the Applicants in the above named suit.

2. That on the 3rd day of June, 1965 (before His Lordship, Mr Justice J. A. Adefarasin, at the High Court, Lagos) I obtained a judgment against the respondent for the sum of £5,161-14s-9d with £105 costs.

3. That on 15-2-68 I registered a Certificate of the said Judgment at the registry of this Honourable Court. The attached marked Annexure "A" is a photo-copy of the said Certificate. I also attach and mark Annexure "B" a Certified True Copy of the said Judgment.

4. That for a period of about 10 months after the judgment had been delivered no part of the judgment debt and costs was paid until I issued a Writ of *Fifa* against the respondent.

5. That as a result of the Writ of *Fifa* the respondent paid altogether a total sum of £1,200 leaving a balance of £4,066-14s-9d.

6. That the respondent left for his home town in the East Central State sometime in October 1966 and also carried away all the movable properties in his house at No. 3 Alamu Street, Surulere, Yaba.

7. That on the 17th day of July, 1967 Mr Justice J. O. Kassim sitting at the High Court No. 7, Lagos, made an order for the sale of the said respondent's house known as No. 3 Alamu Street, Surulere, Yaba. He also awarded 10 guineas costs against the respondent and the award raised the balance outstanding to £4,077-4s-9d.
