ADMISSIONS—SEPTEMBER 1968

The National Technical Teachers Training College is a new Federal Government institution which was opened in October 1967 for the training of technical teachers. It is a joint project with UNESCO.

The next intake of students will be in September 1968 and applications for admission are invited from suitably qualified candidates throughout the Federation.

2. *Courses of study.*—Two types of courses are offered at the College.

(a) A one academic year (ten months) course for those already qualified in their various technical fields but lack pedagogical training. The course is open to "pre-service" and "in-service" candidates. The entry qualification for the one year course will depend on whether the trainee is to teach at a trade centre or vocational school, technical college or commercial institution.

Candidates for training as teachers in trade centres or vocational schools must possess the Advanced Craft (Final) or Full Technological Certificate of City and Guilds in an appropriate craft together with a minimum of two years approved industrial experience. Suitable teaching experience may be accepted in lieu of industrial experience in the case of "in-service" candidates.

Candidates for training as teachers in technical colleges in the fields of Engineering and Building must possess any one of the following qualifications :

A University degree,
Higher National Diploma or Certificate,
Higher Certificate of City and Guilds or
Higher Diploma of Yaba College of Technology,

or other acceptable qualification in Civil, Mechanical, or Electrical Engineering or Building, together with relevant experience.

Commerce candidates must possess either a degree in Commerce, or the Higher National Diploma or Certificate in Business Studies, or the A.C.C.S. or A.C.I.S. or other acceptable qualification, together with relevant experience.

Candidates for training as teachers of Stenography must possess the West African School Certificate with at least a credit in English, or equivalent qualification, together with recognised advanced Certificates in Shorthand and Typewriting (100/50 w.p.m. minimum), and suitable office or teaching experience.

(b) A three-year course involving technical and pedagogical training to prepare candidates as technical teachers in secondary schools. The standard of the course would be equivalent to the present Nigerian Certificate of Education (N.C.E.) course but would have a technical bias. The subjects of the course would include Applied Science, Woodwork, Metalwork and Technical Drawing together with pedagogy and other related subjects.

The necessary entry qualification is the West African School Certificate, with credits in four subjects including English, Mathematics and Science (Physics, Chemistry or Physics with Chemistry).

3. *Conditions of training.*—(a) Successful candidates will be eligible for free board and tuition. In addition, an allowance of £5 a month will be paid to each student. In the case of those students who are not in College hostels, they will be eligible for free tuition plus a monthly allowance of £10 for the duration of the course.

(b) All Students will be required to pay Students' Union Fees of £2 per annum for the duration of their course.

(c) Selection of candidates for the one year course will be by interview. For the three-year course, selection will be by entrance examination and interview.

(d) Preference will be given to sponsored candidates.

4. *Method of application.*—Requests for application Forms should be addressed to the Principal, National Technical Teachers Training College, P.O. Box 269, Yaba, Lagos, together with a stamped self-addressed envelope (9" x 4") to reach him not later than 7th May, 1968. Completed forms must be returned not later than 23rd May, 1968.
