The section of the line through the Escravos Ship Channel will be buried to a minimum depth of 25 feet below the dredged bottom of the channel. The termination of the line at the Valve Platform will be in approximately 15 feet of water.

2. A copy of the plan of the pipeline route identifying the sea bed and land affected can be inspected during all normal working hours at the Ministry of Works, Lands and Transport (Lands Division), Benin City; the Federal Ministry of Mines and Power, Lagos, and the office at 19 Tinubu Square, Lagos, of the aforesaid Company.

3. The Ministry of Works, Lands and Transport (Lands Division), Benin City, shall inquire into objections (if any) duly lodged in accordance with paragraphs 3 and 4 above at the office at Benin City at 10 a.m. on the 22nd day of August, 1968, giving all parties an opportunity to be heard, and reports thereof shall be sent without delay to the Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Mines and Power, Lagos, who shall decide whether or not the Licence shall be granted.

7. Compensation (if any) payable by the aforesaid Company for its use of the sea bed affected shall be determined by negotiations between the Company and those whose interest or interests are affected.
